THE FOLLOWING IS A CHECK LIST OF EXPORT REQUIREMENTS.

1. Complete FAA FORM 8130.1, Application for Export Certificate of Airworthiness. Two (2) Copies.
2. A written statement from the Importing Country that it will validate the Export Airworthiness Approval if the product being exported does not meet their special requirements
3. Aircraft must have undergone an Annual Inspection performed and properly documented within thirty (30) days before the date the application is made for an Export Certificate of airworthiness.
4. Temporary Airworthiness Certificate and Registration Numbers from the Importing Country. (If applicable)
5. The aircraft have a current weight and balance and a current equipment list.
6. Evidence of compliance with applicable Airworthiness Directives, and all historical records, such as, aircraft and engine logbooks, repair and alternation forms, etc., must be available and with aircraft.
7. Two Bills of Sale all signed in ink and notarized from last Registered Owner to Foreign Purchaser.
8. The aircraft must conform to Specifications, and must have the required Placards, Operating Limitations, or Flight Manual.
9. Submit a statement certifying the United States Identification and Registration Numbers have been removed from the aircraft.
10. Copy of your letter requesting cancellation of U.S. Registration and Airworthiness Certificate.

After all the above has been accomplished, please contact our office to make arrangements for our inspection and issuance of an Export Certificate of Airworthiness.
